- Thread-safe execution
- Faster also in single-thread
- Extensible and self-optimizing
- Community walking (branch next for 2.0.11)
- Simple recursion (branch next for 2.0.11)


Asynchronous route export (v3 only)

- Table updates stored in a journal
- Lockless table read (partially)
- Plans: asynchronous route import?
- Asynchronous CLI show route (in progress)
- Deadlock prevention
- Separate table cleanup thread


Protocol thread separation

- BFD (always had its thread)
- **BGP** (one thread per peer)
- Pipe (one thread per pipe)
- RPKI
- Future: all protocols shall have their own thread

- Non-blocking route synchronization (BSD)
